In 2007, the Florida Kidney Disaster Coalition (FKDC) conducted the "All Hazards Educational Series." This program consisted of a pre-quiz, weekly faxblasts on different disaster-related topics, and a post-quiz. Facilities completing both the pre-quiz and post-quiz received a certificate.

FKDC is excited to announce the next All Hazards Educational Series II. Following the same program, this new faxblast series will focus on Conditions for Coverage, H1N1, and other new topics.

You will receive one "All-Hazards Educational Series" faxblast every week for six weeks. If you miss a fax, check the FKDC website (www.fkdc.org) to download them as they become available. Compile each faxblast in a notebook. You can add the new topics to your all-hazards handbook and your facility disaster plan.

Facilities are encouraged to complete the pre-quiz to begin their participation in this project. Following the faxblast series, FKDC will issue a post-quiz. **Each facility completing and returning the pre-quiz and the post-quiz will receive an achievement certificate!**

Here's how it works:

- **Complete the attached pre-quiz and fax it back.** Be sure to include your MEDICARE PROVIDER NUMBER, the name of your facility, a contact person, email address, and a contact telephone number.
- **Pre-quizzes are due by JANUARY 18, 2010.**
- You will receive your first topic on January 25. If you miss a week, check the FKDC website to download a copy. There are six topics/weeks. Compile each topic into a folder.
- When the series is complete, fill out and return the post-quiz before MARCH 26 to receive your certificate!
