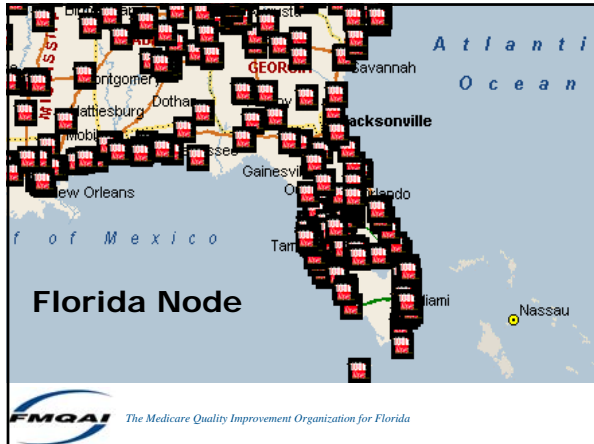




Alignment with 8th Statement of Work

 - Reducing & preventing acute care readmissions from HHAs for surgical wound complications
- Deliver evidence based care
 - AMI & heart failure
 - Reducing & preventing acute care readmissions from HHAs for cardiac related
- Increase Governing Board involvement
- Prevention & treatment of pressure ulcers in LTCs





Environment Scan



- 155 hospitals are enrolled in Florida in the 5M Lives Campaign
- Actively submitting mortality data
- Most started/implemented all applicable interventions
- Affiliated with System Nodes
 - 16 systems are represented

Cape Coral Hospital

- Reduced ventilator associated pneumonia by 50%
 - Ventilator compliance is greater than 95%
- Reduced CLBSI by 50%
 - CLBSI bundle compliance is close to 100%

Lee Memorial Hospital

- Implemented a MET
- 20% of the MET calls result in transfer to ICU
- 56% reduction in Code Blues
