

The ESRD Network consists of numerous boards and committees. The Network Patient Advisory Committee (PAC) lends perspective and gives feedback on educational materials, programs and ESRD issues. The PAC is composed of representatives from facilities, including social workers, dietitians, nurses, patients, family members of patients and transplant recipients.

The PAC:

- Assists in identifying barriers to obtaining quality health care from all perspectives.
- Makes recommendations regarding patient health care messages, materials and activities.
- Provides feedback on effectiveness of the Network's patient activities and assists the Network in recruiting other patients to obtain their perspectives.

The PAC meets three times per year via conference call and also hosts one in-person meeting. The Network reimburses for the cost of travel and one-nights lodging in a hotel for the in-person meeting.
